There have been a number of changes made to our By-laws to take advantage of the latest in technology. The Directors have also made changes to several of our policies to help make the best possible use of our limited resources and to improve our judging process. We work to improve our away show reimbursement policy to fund away shows within the financial limits of our organization. We work with Orchid Quest to assure the best possible show at the lowest possible cost to the Guild. Finally, the Directors support quality programs for our Guild meetings since education is the major function of the Guild as a not-for-profit organization. But unlike the past, this year the Directors are working through the summer to help make our next program year the best yet.

During the next year, the Directors will concentrate on two emerging issues, as well as the normal ones. We will look at potential places to meet in the years ahead that provide easy access and stability of meeting dates. Directions to the Guild Picnic

From the South and Beltline

Highway 51 north to Highway 30.
Right (east) on Highway 30, staying in far right ramp lane to immediately exit onto Thompson.
Left on Thompson (up a hill around curve to left; just beyond a 30 mph sign) to Hazelcrest.
Right on Hazelcrest, one block, to Twin Pines.
Right on Twin Pines. First house on right (gray with maroon trim; you'll see orchids in basement window)

From the East & Interstate

Highway 30 West to Highway 51, staying in far left exit lane.
Left on Highway 51, stay in far left lane under bridge to get back on Highway 30 heading east. Follow directions above, starting on 2nd line.

From the North

Highway 151 south to Zeir Rd. (north side of East Towne).
Left on Zeir to where it ends at Lein Rd.
Left on Lein Rd which becomes Thompson in one block and follow curve up hill to the right
Left on Hazelcrest (2nd street past wooded development on left), one block, to Twin Pines.
Right on Twin Pines. First house on right (gray with maroon trim; you'll see orchids in basement window)
